2016 Accomplishments included managing the construction and retreat schedules that kept the Facilities and Steering Committees busy last year. With the construction schedule limiting the number of retreats we could offer, SHR was still able to provide 9 retreats; a monastic retreat, four small group retreats (by local SRF meditation circles), two work retreats, and two Steering Committee meetings. The construction brought our building closer to "code" and will allow us more flexibility to conduct retreats in the coming year.

2016 Construction Projects

The biggest project was the "breakthrough" which connected the upstairs fire exits on both sides of the house. This improved fire safety in the second floor. Upgrades for fire protection, including new windows on the front, fire alarms throughout, and renovating the bathroom above the refectory were completed. Other building upgrades included bringing the kitchen electrical up to code, creating handicapped access into the first floor, replacing the front door near the Chapel and steps, and installing an air conditioner in the Chapel. The water system was improved by installing a new storage tank and well pump.

Looking Ahead

We are looking forward to the rest of 2017 with great enthusiasm. We hope to have at least one monastic retreat, depending on our construction schedule. Upcoming projects and activities include:

- The second phase of improvements for fire protection. This phase will include replacing seventeen windows in the refectory wing and the dormer, which will bring the second floor up to fire code. Also, the exterior siding on the refectory wing will be replaced.
- **Conducting a "regional" retreat.** This type of retreat would be similar to a "groupconducted" retreat currently hosted by local SRF meditation circles, but would be hosted by lay members from the region and not limited to any particular circle or group. Attendance of our recent "host training" showed an enthusiastic interest in supporting this type of retreat. (Although we have termed this a "regional" retreat, attendance would not be exclusively limited to persons living in the Northeast.)

We hope you can make it to one of our retreats this year. We look forward to serving you in the upcoming year. The SHR Steering Committee:
